Housing Benefit Changes

Housing Benefit is changing and a restriction is being introduced on the number of rooms in a socially rented home which will be covered by Housing Benefit.

Carers will not be allowed an extra bedroom on the basis of not being able to sleep in the same room as their partner due to Illness or disability.

This means that someone providing care to their partner will not be entitled to Housing Benefit for an extra bedroom but someone who has engaged a care worker to provide overnight care will be able to have another bedroom for them.

The Carers Emergency Contact Scheme offers peace of mind that the adult you care for will be looked after in an emergency. The carers emergency card is credit card sized. It is used as an instant source of identification in case the carer has an accident when they are out.

Carers Rights Day took place on the 30th November; the theme was getting help in tough times.

There was a national focus on helping carers access the right financial support, getting the right help, and making the most of technology. With the rising cost of living, salary freezes and job losses many families are struggling to make ends meet, with the additional cost of caring, families affected by illness and disabilities are often the hardest hit.

Staff from Doncaster Carers Centre, were on hand at Doncaster Talking Shop in the High street to offer free help and advice on carers rights and to make carers more aware of the support that may be available to them.

Welfare changes 2013

During the autumn budget under the new reforms chancellor George Osborne announced changes to welfare with most working age benefits seeing real term cuts, however the changes which will become effective from April this year will see Carers allowance and disability benefits exempt from the cuts, and will continue to rise in line with inflation to protect the vulnerable in tough economic times.

Carers allowance which is currently £58.45 a week will see a 2.2 % increase in April 2013 in line with inflation.
